Curriculum for MA(HUMA) (For students admitted in 2010-11)

Program Requirements for Master of Arts (MA) Program in Humanities

Credits

To complete a **minimum of 24 credits** of coursework, including;

- 6 credits of foundation courses;
- 12 credits of required courses; and
- 6 credits of elective courses.

Courses

1. Foundation courses:

HUMA 516	<i>Chinese Historical Phonology</i>
HUMA 538	<i>Modern Literary Theory I</i>
HUMA 555	<i>Field Research: Theory and Practice</i>
HUMA 556	<i>Methods in the Study of Source Materials</i>
HUMA 558	<i>Theories and Methods in East Asian History</i>
HUMA 580	<i>Fundamentals of Chinese Philosophy</i>

2. Required courses:

For every semester, the Program Office will produce a list of courses grouped by fields of concentration. The 4 courses of required courses must be in one of the following fields of concentration: Language and Literature, History and Anthropology, and Philosophy and Religion.

3. Elective courses:

Students can take any PG courses (and a maximum of one UG courses at 300-level) offered by the Division of Humanities.

Study Load

A full-time student is required to take at least 9 courses per semester, whereas a part-time student 3 courses per semester.

Leave from Study

With the approval of the Academic Director, a student may take no more than one semester of study leave.

Credit Transfer

Subject to the approval of the Academic Director, graduates from the GD program may transfer up to 15 credits of coursework to the MA program.

Program Transfer

Subject to the approval of the Academic Director, students of the MA program may subsequently apply for transfer to the GD program.
