HKPFS

Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme

- A prestigious award for the best PhD students from around the world
- **Stipend: HK\$322,800 (~US\$41,400) per year** for 4 years
- **HKUST RedBird PhD Scholarship:** A Recruitment Scholarship of **HK\$40,000 (~US\$5,100)** in the first year and an Academic Excellence Scholarship of **HK\$20,000 (~US\$2,550) per year**, in the following years, subject to the academic performance
- **Conference Travel Allowance: HK\$13,500 (~US\$1,730) per year** for 4 years
- Application deadline: 1 December 2021

- **HK\$216,360 (~US\$27,700) per year**

Asian Future Leaders Scholarship Program

- A scholarship program for young East, Southeast and South Asian scholars to pursue postgraduate studies and cross-cultural enrichment
- MPhil Programs: **HK\$252,000 (~US\$32,411) per year**
- Taught Master's Programs: Full tuition and **HK\$97,188 (~US\$12,500) per year**



Tuition Waiver Scheme for Local Hong Kong MPhil and PhD Students

- **HK\$42,100 (~US\$5,400) per year**
- Up to **2 years** for full-time MPhil students and **4 years** for full-time PhD students



Targeted Taught Postgraduate Programmes Fellowships Scheme

- A fellowship for meritorious local students of selected taught master's programs
- Tuition waiver up to **HK\$120,000 (~US\$15,400)**

Admission Requirements



General Admission Requirements

For all applicants seeking postgraduate admission

- a bachelor's degree from a recognized institution or an approved equivalent qualification

For PhD applicants (additional to the above)

- a proven record of outstanding performance from a recognized institution or presented evidence of satisfactory work at the postgraduate level on a full-time basis for at least one year, or on a part-time basis for at least two years



English Language Requirements

Fulfill the English language requirements with one of the following proficiency attainments¹:

Proficiency Test	Minimum Score
TOEFL – Internet-based Test (iBT) ²	80 (in one single attempt)
TOEFL – Paper-based Test (pBT)	550
TOEFL – Revised Paper-delivered Test	60 (total scores for Reading, Listening and Writing sections)
IELTS (Academic Module) ²	Overall score: 6.5 and all sub-scores: 5.5
Duolingo English Test	105 (accepted only under COVID-19)

¹ You are not required to present TOEFL or IELTS score if your first language is English, or your bachelor's degree (or equivalent qualification) was awarded by an institution where the medium of instruction was English.

² The TOEFL-iBT Home Edition and IELTS Indicator are accepted under COVID-19. Visit pg.ust.hk/covid-19 for details.
