Program Requirements for Master of Philosophy (MPhil) Programs in Accounting / Finance / Information Systems / Marketing / Management / Operation Management *

Credits

To complete **at least 18 credits** of PG coursework, with at least 6 credits of MPhil/PhD level courses in the major field.

Courses

1. Introductory Quantitative Requirements:

ECON	510	<i>Mathematics for Business and Economics</i> ; and
ISOM	581	<i>Introduction to Probability</i>

The credits earned from ECON 510 and ISOM 581 are not counted toward the degree requirements.

2. Common Core Requirements:

To take **2** common core courses:

Program Requirements for Master of Philosophy (MPhil) Program in Economics

Credits

To complete **at least 23 credits** of coursework, with at least 8 credits of MPhil/PhD level courses in the major field.

Courses

1. Introductory Quantitative Requirements:

ECON	510	<i>Mathematics for Business and Economics</i> ; and
ISOM	581	<i>Introduction to Probability</i>

The credits earned from ECON 510 and ISOM 581 are not counted toward the degree requirements.

2. Core Requirements:

To take **4** core courses:

ECON	521	<i>Microeconomic Theory I</i>
ECON	522	<i>Microeconomic Theory II</i>
ECON	530	<i>Econometrics</i>
ISOM	582	<i>Statistical Methods for Business and Economics I</i>

3. Minimum Course Requirements:

ECON	525	<i>Macroeconomic Theory I</i> ; and
ECON	526	<i>Macroeconomic Theory II</i>

Students may need to complete additional courses related to their research topics, as requested by their thesis supervisors.
